The Face of Christ

If you do an image search on Google and type in "Face of Christ", you will find hundreds of different faces; all of which intend to portray Jesus. Even right now as you are reading this, you have an idea in your mind of what Jesus may have looked like.

Moses had an encounter with God on a mountaintop. He sat with Him. Spoke with Him. Listened to Him. And he caught some of God's glory. It says in Exodus that when Moses came down from the mountain, his face was glowing because he had spoken with the Lord. Moses would give his people instruction from God and would then cover his face with a veil until the next time he spoke with the Lord.

2 Corinthians 3:17-18 says, "Now, the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, he gives freedom. And all of us have had that veil removed so that we can be mirrors that brightly reflect the glory of the Lord. Our Step Out 5th grade discipleship group has been serving in the church and community each month and recently we visited a nearby nursing home to talk with and encourage residents. Our weKids Choir partnered with SCAN (Stop Child Abuse Now) and sang for their annual 5K fundraiser run in Short Pump. On March 6th, we had 104 kids present God's Word to hundreds of people through the weKids Production "LOST". The picture of Christ is growing clearer through us!

As school begins to wind down and summer is on the horizon, I encourage you to continue to find ways as a family to be the face of Christ. What an amazing privilege it is to love people the way that God loves people!
